Dear Winnetka-Northfield Chamber Members:

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION THAT MAY
IMPACT YOUR BUSINESS**

All Members invited. Plan to join us at our next Chamber Board Meeting, on Tuesday, May 13, 7:30 a.m. Winnetka Community House to hear Linda Yonke, Superintendent of New Trier High School speak at an open chamber board meeting. New Trier is considering a targeted proposal that would demolish three adjacent buildings that are among the oldest and most inaccessible on campus, replacing them with a new facility. The new building would more than double the amount of student and classroom spaces on the same footprint - going from 125,000 sq. ft. in the old buildings to approximately 275,000 sq. ft. in the new building. The proposal focuses on the 1912 Cafeteria, 1931 Tech Arts Building, and 1950 Music Building. The District anticipates the potential referendum cost would be about half that of the unsuccessful 2010 proposal. The input of groups such as ours is crucial as they try to reach all residents and businesses to help them find a solution the community can support. They are offering general public tours and meetings throughout May, would like to continue offer sessions within all affected communities as well.
