The Village of Winnetka's Public Works Department will be conducting contractual maintenance and repairs on the Hubbard Woods Parking Garage on Scott Avenue. Work is scheduled to begin Monday April 7, 2014 weather permitting. The project repairs will include; modified concrete and mortar repairs and maintenance, joint sealing, moisture protection, traffic coatings, and drainage system repairs. The work will take place in phases from approximately April 7, 2014 through June 30, 2014 weather dependent.
